*“Please be advised that the final working meeting of the Cobourg Accommodation Review Committee (ARC) was held December 18th. The ARC process is now complete. As a result of the work of the ARC and community consultation, revisions to the **Final Recommendations** and **Guiding Principles**, (as presented at the Public Meeting held on November 20, 2017 with regard to the proposed closure of St. Michael CES and boundary changes impacting Notre Dame CES and St. Joseph CES) are posted on the school board website. - Students in the above grades who are identified with urgent treatment needs may be rescreened at a later date.

Dental checks are conducted by a Registered Dental Hygienist. This check does not replace your child's regular dental visit. You will be advised of your child's recommended dental needs.
